Child Care Choice Vouchers offer short-term child care tuition assistance for families in Snohomish County who meet income eligibility.

A Family Access Navigator is available to help you find child care that fits your family's needs, determine your eligibility for assistance, and connect you with additional supports. Navigators can also help you apply for Working Connections Child Care and link you to a wide range of family resources.
